TAVISTOCK COUNTRY CLUB HOUSE RULES Visit Our Website www.tavistockcc.org

Our Club has a reputation for being gracious and friendly. We are a family Club and as members of a big family, each should strive to respect the rights and privileges of the other. These rules, therefore, are not an attempt to instruct our members and their families in matters of customary and respectable conduct, but to point out certain expectations of everyone in our Club environment that otherwise might be overlooked. Always be aware that members in our Club are judged by their attitude and cooperation with the rules.

GENERAL:

- 1. There shall be no parking of cars in any place other than the parking spaces provided. Absolutely no parking will be tolerated in fire lanes.
- 2. Drivers should observe the one-way restrictions on the parking lot as evidenced by the arrows.
- 3. Space has been reserved for handicap parking. Please observe this restriction.
- 4. Tavistock is a non-smoking facility in all of its interior Clubhouse, Golf Shop, Maintenance Facility, and Halfway House areas and any indoor facility in accordance with New Jersey State Law. Cigarette and cigar smoking is permitted outdoors after dining hours on the Patio, and anytime outdoors on the new Winter Lounge patio only. Smoking is not permitted outside the front entrance in the Portico area. The designated smoking area for all banquets is the upstairs balcony area.
- 5. Any use of the TCC Membership Directory or other Club information for non-member use is prohibited.
- 6. The use of Club information including the TCC website is designed for member use only.
- 7. Photographs may be taken at various golf and social club events while you are at the Club. These photos may be used on our Club website or in the TCC newsletter. Please contact the General Manager if you do not wish to have your photo taken.
- 8. All updates to the House Rules will be provided on our website www.tavistockcc.org.

DRESS CODE:

Members, their children, and guests should always dress according to the dictates of good taste and in keeping with the character of our fine Club. Whether in the Clubhouse or on the golf course, one's attire must reflect a high degree of respect for our fellow members and our guests. Members are responsible, not only for themselves, but for the dress of their children and their guests as well. Although our Club caters to varying degrees of formality, it is possible to dress so that no one is offended. No one is permitted access to the golf course or clubhouse unless in full conformance with the Dress Code. Our staff has been instructed to inform anyone who is improperly attired. If informed by the staff that one's dress is improper, the staff member is not to be questioned. Denim / Jeans are permitted in the Lounge, Terrace, Alexander Findlay Veranda, Alexander Findlay Bar, Alexander Findlay Wine Room, Samuel E. Fulton Grille Room, and Golf Shop only. Frayed, ripped, faded, excessively loose, or soiled denim is not permitted. Golf attire is defined as follows: Men may wear full-length trousers or conservatively tailored shorts no more than 3" above or below the knee; shirts must be tucked in and have sleeves and a collar (except for the approved short or long sleeve mock turtleneck designed for golf). Denim is permitted in designated areas of the clubhouse but, cargo shorts / pants are not permitted in any area of the Clubhouse. Women may wear slacks, shorts, or skirts; shorts and skirts must be no higher than 4" above the top of the knee. Shirts may be sleeveless or collarless as long as they are designed for golf. Business casual is defined as a collared shirt and Khaki style pants. Golf shirts are to be tucked in while in the Clubhouse or on the golf course. Men's headwear should be removed within the confines of the Clubhouse, which excludes the January 2024

Golf Shop. Men's short sleeved button-down square cut bottom (cut and sewn) shirts to be worn as designed which is outside of trousers or shorts and not tucked in ("Tommy Bahama" style) are permitted in the Clubhouse. Inappropriate clothing includes that which is torn, frayed, ripped, faded, excessively loose, or soiled denim. T-shirts, tank tops, sweatpants, cargo shorts, sweat suits and swimsuits are not permitted. Questions may be directed in writing to the House Committee. The Infractions Committee will adjudicate Dress Code disputes. Although common sense will usually dictate what the appropriate attire is, the following are offered as guidelines:

GOLF COURSE: Men must wear full-length trousers or conservatively tailored shorts no higher than 3" above the top of the knee; shirts must be tucked in and have sleeves and a collar (except for the approved short sleeve mock turtleneck designed for golf). Women may wear slacks, shorts, or skirts; shorts and skirts must be no higher than 4" above the top of the knee. Shirts may be sleeveless or collarless if they are designed for golf wear. Denim and cargo shorts are prohibited.

SPIKES: Tavistock Country Club is a soft spike only facility. Changing shoes should be done in the golf shop or locker room and more specifically **not** in the parking lot.

LOCKER ROOM FACILITIES: Please use good judgement with appropriate casual attire (denim / jeans permitted) in consideration of your fellow members. Also, for aesthetic and sanitary reasons, please confine bare feet to the shower area.

CHILDREN AND TEENAGERS: (Conforming with NJ State Law)

1. No person under 21 years of age shall be served alcohol beverages.

2. Children under 18 years of age will not be allowed the use of the men's or women's locker room in the Clubhouse unless accompanied by an adult.

3. Children under the age of 21 will not be permitted to sit at any bar.

4. Children under 18 years of age will not be allowed in the lounge area unless accompanied by an adult.

5. Children under 18 years of age are permitted to use the veranda outside the lounge provided they are dressed in proper attire and conduct themselves appropriately.

6. Young men (ages 16-20) may utilize the men's locker room and bar area when accompanied by an adult who must assume responsibility for their guidance. To clarify all young men under the age of 16 will not be permitted in the locker room bar area. Over the age of 21, assuming that the young man is a member he may utilize the facility without being accompanied by an adult.

DINING ROOMS:

Lounge— the dress is casual (golf attire / denim/jeans permitted) for this room. No reservations are taken for the Lounge.

Terrace— the dress is casual (golf attire / denim/jeans permitted) for this room. The maximum table size in this room is 8 people. Reservations are encouraged for lunch and dinner.

The 1921 Room – the dress is business casual (denim/jeans are <u>not</u> permitted) for this room for lunch and dinner. The maximum table size in this room is 10 people. Reservations are encouraged for lunch and dinner.

Alexander Findlay Veranda – the dress is casual (golf attire / denim/jeans permitted) for this room. Reservations are encouraged for lunch and dinner.

Alexander Findlay Bar – the dress is casual (golf attire / denim/jeans permitted) for this area. No reservations are taken for the Bar.

Alexander Findlay Wine Room – the dress is casual (golf attire / denim/jeans permitted) for this room. The maximum table size in this room is 10 people. Reservations are encouraged for lunch and dinner.

Samuel E. Fulton Grille Room — the dress is casual (golf attire / denim/jeans permitted) for this room. The maximum table size in this room is 12 people. Reservations are encouraged for lunch and dinner.

The Founders' Board Room – the dress is business casual (denim/jeans are <u>not</u> permitted) for both lunch and dinner. There is a maximum of 34 people permitted in this room with planned menus. A la Carte dining may be available and there may be special fees and or minimum gratuity for use of this room. Please contact the Club office.

The Men's Grille - the dress is casual (golf attire / denim/jeans permitted) for this room. Beverage service ends at 2:00 a.m. Last call is at 1:40 a.m. At 2:00 a.m. All members must exit the Club.

The Bean on the Green Coffee Shop Dress Code

The Bean on the Green Coffee Shop will be open daily from 7:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. The normal Tavistock Country Club "house" dress code applies, except for the limited time daily from 7:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m., when members and their guests may visit the coffee shop in "tasteful" athletic attire. Tasteful athletic attire specifically excludes shorts or skirts higher than 4 inches above knee, torn, sloppy or untailored clothing, exposed undergarments, see through fabric without proper lining and bare midriffs, hooded sweatshirts, and headwear for gentlemen. Also, during the limited time daily from 7:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m., cell phone and laptop usage will be permitted in the Bean on the Green. Please be considerate of your fellow members by keeping the volume to a minimum.

CELL PHONES & PORTABLE ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY:

As members of Tavistock Country Club we are encouraged to always be considerate of our fellow members, their families and guests when on Club Property. For everyone's consideration the following policy permits the use of today's portable electronic devices including cellular/smart phones, laptops, iPads, and game gear without interfering in members and their guest's enjoyment and leisure time at Tavistock Country Club. The Policy includes all Club Property including the Clubs Buildings, Patio Areas and the Golf Course.

AS THE MEMBER, PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU AND ALL YOUR GUESTS ADHERE TO THE CLUB'S POLICY. IF WE CAN HELP IN ANYWAY PLEASE ASK OUR STAFF FOR ASSISTANCE.

<u>Cell /Smart Phone</u>: Portable phones should always be in the **Off** or **Vibrate** mode when you are on Club property. When a call is received or a call must be made one should immediately go to a private area where

other members/guests will not hear your conversation. Outdoors, and away from other members/guests or the locker areas are recommended locations. If you receive a call while on the golf course or practice areas please leave the area of play, conclude the call quickly and **Never Hold up the Pace of Play**.

<u>Smart Phone APPs</u>: Sending, receiving text messages, e-mails and other electronic messages is acceptable as long as your device is silent and does not interfere with other members/guests enjoyment and the pace of play.

<u>Laptops/iPads</u>: Use of Laptops, sending e-mails and other electronic messages is acceptable as long as your device is silent and does not interfere with other members/guests enjoyment. Members, their families and guests should exercise sensible judgment when using their laptop computers. Any conduct that is impermissible by law is impermissible on Tavistock Club Property and while using the Clubs Wi-Fi service. The entire clubhouse is 100% Wi-Fi. The membership may access this service free of charge. **The Password throughout the Clubhouse is tavistock**.

LAPTOP COMPUTERS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE GOLF COURSE OR PRACTICE AREAS.

<u>IPads & Game Gear</u>: Use of IPads and Hand Held Game Gear is acceptable in the Lounge or Outdoor Patio areas only as long as your device is silent and does not interfere with other members/guests enjoyment. Members, their families and guests should exercise sensible judgment on all electronic content.

MISCELLANEOUS:

- 1. The Club shall not be responsible for the loss of property, or for any other loss sustained by members or their guests while on Club premises. The lost and found is located in the Club office.
- 2. Employees must not be interfered with, or reprimanded by members of the Club. All complaints or suggestions should be made to the General Manager, Clubhouse Manager or to the House Committee or Infractions Committee Chairmen.
- 3. Members, guests and visitors who damage or destroy Club property will be charged for such damage and destruction as the Infractions Committee may determine.
- 4. No notices, subscriptions, papers or petitions except such as are related to Club affairs shall be posted or circulated at the Club.
- 5. The General Manager, Golf Professional, Greens Superintendent or designated Tavistock employees shall inform members or guests of any violations of Tavistock rules. It is the responsibility of Tavistock members to alert management of any apparent house rule violation. Any formal complaint must be submitted in writing to the Infractions Committee.
- 6. It shall be the duty of the General Manager to maintain proper decorum at the Club and report any violation of rules to the House Committee or Infractions Committee Chairmen.
- 7. No article belonging to the Club shall be removed from the grounds or the Clubhouse without the express permission of the General Manager.
- TCC accepts personal checks and credit card payments through a third party vendor Plastiq (<u>https://TavistockCountryClub.plastiq.com</u>) for payment of member's house accounts and dues.
- 9. The member sponsor of a non-member event will be responsible for full payment in the event the party defaults on payment after 60 days.
- 10. Televisions will be turned on by request. There will be no sound and it will be primarily a sports environment. The bartender will control the remote control.
- 11. Hole In One Policy: Once a hole in one is made, drinks are limited to one drink per person while the golfer having the hole in one is at the Club. Once the person leaves the Club the generosity of the hole in

one is no longer in place. The Golf Shop will notify the Lounge Bar and Men's Grille bartenders that a hole in one has occurred.
